## KIRBY CORPORATION TO ANNOUNCE 2001 THIRD QUARTER RESULTS ON OCTOBER 18, 2001

Houston, Texas (October 11, 2001) -- Kirby Corporation ("Kirby") (NYSE:KEX) will announce its 2001 third quarter results before the market opens on Thursday, October 18, 2001. A conference call to discuss the third quarter will be held at 10:00 a.m. central time that morning.

Through its diesel engine services segment, Kirby provides after-market service for large medium-speed diesel engines used in marine, power generation, industrial, nuclear and rail applications.
